

How to Measure for a Wig

There are three easy steps to follow.

*Note: You will need a cloth measuring tape.

Step 1: Begin the tape measure at the front hair line and follow around to the back of the neck hairline and back around to the front. This will give you the circumference, which usually is anywhere from 19 to 23 inches.



Step 2: Begin at the front hair line and follow across the top of the head to the nape of the neck hair line. This should measure 12 to 15 inches.



Step 3: Starting in at the top front of the ear across the top crown of the head to the other ear. This should measure 11 to 14 inches.



Using these three measurements, you can determine the size of wig you will need.

Try to select a wig size from the chart below.

Wig Sizes	Around the head	Front to Back	Ear to ear
Child	19"	12"	12"
Petite	21"	13 ¼"	13"
Petite/Avg	21 ¼"	13 ¾"	13 ¼"
Average	21½"	14¼"	13½"
Avg / Lrg	22¼"	14¾"	13 ¾"
Large	23"	15¾"	14"
