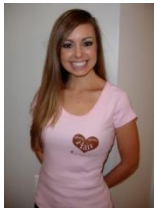


Survivor of the Month HEIDI GRISSOM

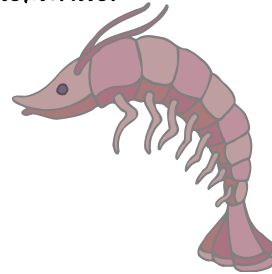

Recipe of the Month
Barbeque Shrimp
In Loving Memory of Jeff Alexander

- 3 tbsp Worcestershire
- 1 jar barbecue sauce
- 1 tbsp garlic salt
- 1/2 tsp red pepper
- 1 tbsp Accent
- 1 lb butter
- 5 lbs shrimp, raw



Mix first five ingredients. Melt butter, add to mixture and pour over 5 pounds of shrimp. Refrigerate for 2 hours. Bake, uncovered, for about 45 minutes at 350 degrees.
