Recipe of the Month

Blueberry Coffee Cake In Memory of Brenda Walker



COFFEE CAKE

2 pkgs. Blueberry muffin mix
1 c sour cream
2 eggs
1/2 c milk

FILLING

8 oz. cream cheese

STREUSEL

1 c brown sugar
2/3 c plain flour
1 tsp cinnamon
1/2 c. margarine

Drain blueberries; mix sour cream and eggs, stir in milk. Add the mix and stir until moist. Spread 1/2 batter in 9 x 13 inch pan that has been sprayed with Pam. Top with 1/2 berries and 1/2 streusel. Cut cream cheese into small pieces and put over the layer. Add remaining batter, berries and streusel and bake at 400 degrees for 25-30 minutes.
